



**Memorandum of  
Cooperation  
between  
EYE and EILL**



European Young Engineers MTÜ (EYE) is a non-profit organization representing more than 250.000 young engineers and students in Europe from 20 national member associations in 16 countries.

EYE offers its member organizations and their active students and young professionals the access to a Europe-wide network by linking national engineering associations. It is a platform for contacts between students, engineers, industry and society to share knowledge, fostering mobility and developing personal and professional skills.

The European Institute for Industrial Leadership a.i.s.b.l. (EILL) helps industrial companies to attract, retain and develop their next generation leaders. Together with its global network of members, partners and individuals the EILL researches issues these leaders will face in their workplace of the future. Knowledge is generated by research consortia and shared within an active network through conferences and developmental workshops.

EILL's members and partners include companies and industry associations and other dissemination partners from the chemicals, plastics and engineering & construction and automotive sectors.

Both organizations agree to develop at least the following cooperation activities:

- Regular exchange of information on events and projects that each organization is planning
- Permanent invitations to publish information from or about the other organization, its objective, and projects, including also position papers, presentations and other formats that deal with the engineering education and the engineering profession, or more generally leadership skills required for the future career or workplace in which a young engineer may find themselves engaged. This shall be done via available public relation channels (website, newsletter, social media, etc.). Any intellectual property rights (IPR) pertaining to any material to be published will remain with the originating party.
- By invitation send a representative in a non-voting right capacity in meetings and workings groups set up by each organization to deal with subjects related to the education of engineers as well as the profession of engineering, or more generally leadership skills required for the future career or workplace in which a young engineer may find themselves engaged.
- Invitations to publish, whenever appropriate, common position papers on subjects dealing the education and the profession of engineers, or more generally leadership skills required for the future career or workplace in which a young engineer may find themselves engaged.
- The mutual support in the organization of events, e.g. by organizing joint events or supplying speakers for plenary talks or workshops



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The list can be amended/complemented at any time on request and with the agreement of both organizations.

Each organization will nominate one person responsible for the contact between the two organizations in charge of implementing above points of cooperation. They will be in contact or meet whenever necessary. They will report to their corresponding Executive Board.

The final objective of this cooperation is to set up a long-lasting and close collaboration between the European Young Engineers and the European Institute for Industrial Leadership.

This Memorandum of Cooperation is unlimited in time. Each organization may decide at any time to put an end to it by informing in writing the other organization.
